

**1 Project Aim**

**Dissemination**

- Our International Conference will take place 2<sup>nd</sup> – 4<sup>th</sup> June 2014 at the Royal College of Physicians in Edinburgh.
- WP4 has submitted a poster about applying the GRADE approach through evaluating evidence to Diagnostic Test Accuracy Reviews to the Cochrane Colloquium in Auckland, 2012.
- WP2 has submitted a poster: “The DECIDE Project: Policy Makers and Managers focused strategies to go from Evidence to Coverage Decision”, also to the Cochrane Colloquium in Auckland

**Collaboration**

- WP6 participated in a meeting with the German Robert Koch Institute and members of ECDC. This group would like to collaborate on DECIDE GRADE EtR Framework.
- WP5 used the HS EtR framework at an EtR workshop at the [SURE](#) (Supporting the Use of Research Evidence) international forum in Addis Ababa in August. SURE is an FP7 funded project which Dr Andy Oxman currently coordinates.
