

## 1 Project Aim

To Improve the dissemination of evidence – based recommendations by building on the work of the GRADE Working Group to develop and evaluate methods that address the targeted dissemination of guidelines

### Highlights

- **WP1:** For the Evidence to Recommendations framework for guideline developers the results from 4 user tests were analyzed, as well as a workshop and feedback from the GRADE working group.
- A stakeholder group were consulted about WP3’s general approach, and their views on the iSoF tables. .
- **WP4** submitted a manuscript on the systematic review of grading systems for medical test guideline development to Implementation Science and are waiting for a reply.
- **WP5:** new versions of the Health System and Public Health Evidence to Decision (EtD) frameworks are ready for user testing.
- **WP6** work on GRADEpro and integration with the guideline development tool is continuing. A revised EtR framework for diagnosis has been drafted.

## Dissemination

- Our International Conference will take place 2<sup>nd</sup> – 4<sup>th</sup> June 2014 at the Royal College of Physicians in Edinburgh.
- **WP2:** The DECIDE project was presented during an international workshop in Rome: “Challenges for epidemiology in the context of the National Health Service”.
- **WP5’s** survey of policymakers has been submitted for publication.
- **WP6** presented aspects of DECIDE at a keynote for International Society of Quality of Life Research in Budapest, Hungary.

## Collaboration

- **WP4** are currently planning a set of in-depth interviews with a number of international guideline developers to be conducted between November 2012 and January 2013.
- **WP5** has planned collaborations with groups from Colombia and Chile.
- **WP6** held a GRADE Working Group meeting in Auckland, New Zealand.
