### Project Aim

To Improve the dissemination of evidence – based recommendations by building on the work of the GRADE Working Group to develop and evaluate methods that address the targeted dissemination of guidelines

## Highlights

- WP3: Producing revised user testing materials; further user tests to be carried out in all parts of Scotland, extend user testing to include breast cancer.
- WP5: The first electronic version of the interactive Summary of Findings table (iSoF) has been programmed. An interactive decision framework is beginning to be developed, and this will have the same look and feel as the iSoF. Ways to user test the Recommendation to Decision (RtD) framework in the context of the WHO recommendations are being explored (optimizing health worker roles for maternal and newborn health). Also. WP5's Evidence to Recommendation (EtR) framework has been translated into Spanish and will be user tested in Colombia.
