Project Aim

To Improve the dissemination of evidence – based recommendations by building on the work of the GRADE Working Group to develop and evaluate methods that address the targeted dissemination of guidelines.

Highlights

The Chief Medical Officer for Scotland, Sir Harry Burns, has agreed to give an opening address at the DECIDE conference next year.

WP2 are developing a framework on dis-coverage to be presented at the 21st Cochrane Collaboration in Quebec.

Initial user tests of breast cancer version are being conducted by WP3 and a literature review report is being drafted.

WP4's systematic review of grading systems published in Implementation Science (URL: http://www.implementationscience.com/content/8/1/78) has been flagged by the journal as "highly accessed". The findings of the paper will also be presented at an upcoming WHO guideline panel meeting in September in Geneva, Switzerland. The paper was featured in AHRQ's Comparative Effectiveness Research Methodology Library (http://www.citeulike.org/user/SRCMethodsLibrary)

Shaun Treweek has accepted an invitation to speak and talk part in a meeting held at the European Monitoring Centre for Drugs and Drug Addiction (EMCDDA). Lisbon to talk about collaboration with DECIDE.
