This deliverable involved the development of a database of evidence profiles (DBEP) prepared using GRADEpro strategies developed by DECIDE, the aim of which is to facilitate collaboration across European guideline developers.</p> <p>This work builds on a pilot database developed by the GRADE Working Group, and the profile database accommodates the changing and evolving nature of the grading methodology over time (such as empirical evidence from DECIDE).</p> <p>DECIDE will continue to focus on adding functionality of DBEP and GRADE Guideline Development Tool (G²DT) that will allow developing and presenting summaries of the evidence and recommendations based on information from diagnostic test accuracy studies, interactive versions of evidence profiles and presentation of the results from network meta-analyses that will result from other work packages within the project.</p> <p>-----</p> <p>DECIDE aims to regularly promote and disseminate its work to a wide audience.
