

1 Project Aim

To build on the work of the GRADE Working Group and develop and evaluate strategies for the **targeted communication** of evidence-based recommendations to health professionals, the public and policymakers.

Highlights

- Ethical approval was given for a new method of approaching potential focus group participants in Scotland (a register of individuals interested in taking part in research), which if successful will be a method which can be used in other parts of WP3, particularly user-testing.
