

# DECIDE Round - Up May 2014



Project Aim	News
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<p>To improve the dissemination of evidence based recommendations by building on the work of the GRADE Working Group to develop and evaluate methods that address the targeted dissemination of guidelines.</p> <p>May sees the final stages of planning and organising for our conference in Edinburgh. Posters have been produced by each project Work Package (WP) and can be viewed on the project website.</p> <p>About two thirds of those attending have completed the doodle poll to indicate the workshop sessions they would be interested in attending. If you have registered for the conference and have yet to complete the poll it would be great if you could do so as this will assist with our planning and should help things run that little bit more smoothly on the day. See also the conference Twitter account: @decide_2014</p>	<p>To date, WP3 have reviewed 5415 records and included 26 studies (10 qualitative studies, 13 cross sectional and 3 randomised controlled trials) involving 24,887 individuals. Studies were mostly good to fair quality. The main themes that have arisen from these studies will be described in more detail at the conference (see WP3 posters).</p> <p>WP4 have held 10 in-depth interviews with guideline developers from various countries and in various fields of medical testing. A manuscript is in preparation about the results of these interviews.</p> <p>WP5 continue to develop 'GET IT' - the Glossary of Evaluation Terms for Informed Treatment choices in plain language. There is a conference workshop covering this on Wednesday 4 June from 09:00-10:30.</p> <p>WP6 has two project deliverables remaining: (i) creating a database of evidence profiles (due August 2014) and (ii) a toolkit for preparing and disseminating evidence-based recommendations (due February 2015). Work is ongoing, and there are 5 workshops about the Guideline Development Tool (GDT) on offer over the duration of the conference, including hands-on sessions where you will be able to develop your own guideline.</p>
